The Intensive Residential Treatment Program

Laurel Heights Hospital provides psychiatric treatment for children and adolescents ages 7 - 21 with severe and complex psychiatric and behavioral difficulties impacting multiple areas of functioning. Children are placed within separate units based on age, gender and special treatment needs. This ensures that programming can be tailored to specific developmental needs, in addition to, individualized treatment issues.

- Self-injurious, disruptive and aggressive behaviors
